Notice for Students of B.A./B.Sc./B.Com. Semester-I Admitted through the **Stand-Alone Mode (College Admission Portal)**

It is hereby notified to all the students admitted to **B.A./B.Sc./B.Com. Semester-I** through the Stand-Alone Mode (College Admission Portal) that they must log in to the Syamaprasad College Admission Portal and do the followings within 26th October, 2024, for proper execution of the university registration process:

- 1. Complete Profile
- 2. Select IDC

Failing to do so within the stipulated time may lead to cancellation of the university registration process.

Furthermore, it is *absolutely necessary* for every student to create his/her own *Academic Bank* of Credits (ABC) IDs for university registration. You can create your own ABC ID by following the steps outlined in the video link below:



Open the Syamaprasad College Admission Portal in your web browser using the link below:



- 2. Select IDC









Click on 'Complete Profile' tab. Here, you will find that most of the data are pre-filled. You will have to carefully check all and update/type in if necessary. In the communication information section, you must put your ABC ID as shown below:




Then click on 'Update' and come back to Home. click on 'Select IDC' tab. Here, you have to select 3 IDCs for three consecutive semesters. After properly selecting courses click on 'Save and Confirm'. Then go back to 'Home' and print your form by clicking on 'Print Form'.



How to Choose Your IDC:

For 4-Years B.Com. Honours Students:

• Two **IDC**s namely Microeconomics and Macroeconomics are to be selected for first and second semester, respectively.

For 3-Years B.Com. Multidisciplinary Students:

Two IDCs namely Microeconomics and Macroeconomics are to be selected for first and second semester, respectively.

For 4-Years B.A. Honours Students:

Three different **IDC** subjects must be taken for first, second and third semesters, respectively. The subject of choice for IDC must be different from the subjects taken as Major, Minor1 and Minor2.

Choices for IDC are as follows: Bengali, English, Education, Economics, English, French, Geography, Hindi, History, Philosophy, Political Science, Sanskrit.

For example, a student of Bengali Major having History and Political Science as Minor1 and Minor2, respectively must not take Bengali, History and Political Science as IDC.

For 3-Years B.A. Multidisciplinary Students:

Three different **IDC** subjects must be taken for first, second and third semesters, respectively. The subject of choice for IDC must be different from the subjects taken as CC1, CC2 and Minor.

Choices for IDC are as follows: Bengali, English, Education, Economics, English, French, Geography, Hindi, History, Philosophy, Political Science, Sanskrit.

For example, a student with CC1 Bengali, CC2 History and Minor Political Science, respectively must not take Bengali, History and Political Science as IDC.

For 4-Years B.Sc. Honours Students:

Three different **IDC** subjects must be taken for first, second and third semesters, respectively. The subject of choice for IDC must be different from the subjects taken as Major, Minor1 and Minor2.

Choices for IDC are as follows: Botany, Computer Science, Economics, Electronics, Geography, Mathematics, Physics, Physiology, Statistics, Zoology.

For example, a student of Mathematics Major having Computer Science and Electronics as Minor1 and Minor2, respectively must not take Mathematics, Computer Science and Electronics as IDC.

For 3-Years B.Sc. Multidisciplinary Students:

• Three different **IDC** subjects must be taken for first, second and third semesters, respectively. The subject of choice for IDC must be different from the subjects taken as CC-1, CC-2 and Minor.

<u>Choices for IDC are as follows:</u> Botany, Computer Science, Economics, Electronics, Geography, Mathematics, Physics, Physiology, Statistics, Zoology.

However, students of <u>B.Sc. Multidisciplinary with Bio-Science</u> will choose their IDCs from the following list: *Bengali, Computer Science, English, Education, Economics, Electronics, English, French, Geography, Hindi, History, Mathematics, Philosophy, Physics, Political Science, Sanskrit, Statistics.*

For example, a student having CC1 Mathematics, CC2 Computer Science and Minor Electronics, respectively must not take Mathematics, Computer Science and Electronics as IDCs.
